



Application Form for Clerks' CiLCA Bursary Scheme in Wales

Community & town council clerks and their administrative assistants are welcome to apply for a bursary funding registration of the CiLCA qualification. This scheme closes on 28.02.2020 (or once all bursaries have been claimed)

The criteria to receive a Wales Bursary is as follows:

- Bursary limit is £350 and this will cover the registration costs for the qualification. There are only a limited number of bursaries available, and you will be notified within 7 days of receipt if you have been awarded one.
- The bursary scheme is aimed at small / medium councils and is open to any clerk or administrative assistant who works for a **council with a turnover** (i.e. annual budgeted income) **of under £100,000.**
- The registration of CiLCA must take place within 30 days of receiving your code to input on the SLCC website, or your bursary will be terminated and offered to another applicant.
