What are the benefits of being part of the PDS?

- Use the designated letters 'StSLCC', 'PSLCC' or 'FSLCC' after your name and get your name on the SLCC website during your membership to confirm your status
- A £10 (Student), £20 (Principal) or £30 (Fellow) training voucher to use against any SLCC CPD course or training event within the year of your membership*
- Use the designated logo on your CV and/or job applications
- A PDS pin badge to wear at events and training
- A certificate confirming your professional status
- Three news bulletins offering the latest training news, advice on gaining CPD points and support with professional development.

How much will my membership cost?

In addition to your Full or Affiliate membership, the cost to become a Student, Principal or Fellow member is:

Student Membership - £15

Principal Membership - £55

Fellow Membership - £85

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How can I become a member of the Professional Development Scheme?



The criteria for becoming a Student member is:

Full membership **AND** 12 CPD points per membership year



The criteria for becoming a Principal member is:

Full or Affiliate membership

AND

Passed the Certificate in Local Council Administration (CiLCA)

OR

Passed the CertHE at Level 4 of Local Policy

OR

Passed Level 4 of Community Engagement & Governance

OR

Passed Level 4 of Community Governance

OR

Passed the Certificate in Local Council Administration Parts 1 & 2 before 1993

AND

18 CPD points per membership year



The criteria for becoming a Fellow member is:

Route 1

Full or Affiliate membership

AND

Passed Foundation Degree in Community Engagement & Governance

OR

The Foundation Degree in Community Governance

OR

The Diploma of Higher Education in Local Policy

AND

5 years relevant sector experience and made a significant contribution to the sector

AND

24 CPD points per membership year

OR

Route 2

Full or Affiliate membership

AND

Passed the Certificate in Local Council Administration (CiLCA)

AND

A qualification at level 5 or above

AND

8 years relevant sector experience and made a significant contribution to the sector

AND

24 CPD points per membership year
