Your CPD is important and it matters!

As a member of the SLCC taking part in CPD is encouraged. You can opt in at any point from the time you become a member and continue for as long as your membership remains current. However, in addition the Society also has developed a Professional Development Scheme (PDS) to help you achieve the understanding and expertise that are expected of today's local councils' professionals.

You can join the PDS at Student, Principal or Fellow level. CPD is mandatory, and you will need to accumulate 12, 18 or 24 CPD points respectively each year. The number of points will differ depending on the type of activity you complete and you can spread your development across many areas. (*See the table as over.*)

Your CPD record is completed on line by accessing 'Your SLCC' from the SLCC website. You can use this in appraisals, job interviews or wherever you want to illustrate your dedication to developing and maintaining your knowledge and skills.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is there a fee for my CPD?

A: No, the CPD programme is a free membership benefit for all SLCC Members.

Q: How do I record my CPD?

A: Everyone has their own CPD record, accessible from "Your SLCC" on the SLCC website.

Q: What other activities attract CPD points.

A: You can gain CPD Points in many ways as shown in the table.

Q: How many CPD points do I need each year?

A: There is no minimum number – however if you join the Professional Development Scheme then you need 12 CPD pts each year as a Student, 18CPD points as a Principal and 24 CPD points as a Fellow.

Q: What are the benefits of joining the Professional Development Scheme?

A: There are a number of benefits including: -

- ⇒ Members are entitled to use the designated letters 'StSLCC', 'PSLCC' / 'FSLCC' after their name which will be published on the SLCC website during their membership to confirm their status.
- ⇒ Members will receive a training voucher to use against any SLCC CPD course or training event within the first year of their membership.
- ⇒ Members can use the designated 'Student / Principal / Fellow member' logo on their CV and job applications.
- ⇒ Members will receive a 'Student / Principal / Fellow member' pin badge to wear at events and training.
- ⇒ Members will receive three Professional Development, news bulletins offering the latest training news, advice on gaining CPD points and support with professional development.
